

Sports Day: The Chelsea Academy Games 2018

Dear Parents / Carers

On Monday 25th June 2018 we will be holding our annual Chelsea Academy Games (Sports Day) at Battersea Park's Millennium Stadium. As well as the regular athletics activities taking place inside the stadium, every student will be competing for their House in a number of different activities, including Rounders, Handball, Volleyball and Cricket throughout the day in the park.

Your child will be off-site for the whole day on Monday 25th June. It is important that students arrive promptly to the Academy at 8:35am in full Academy PE kit. If they arrive without full Academy kit or in the incorrect kit (including Adidas / Nike branded sportswear), they will be given a replacement kit or sent home to change. If they are entitled to free school meals the Academy will provide them with a packed lunch. There will be water available to buy on the day but no lunch food so, **if you pay for school meals, please provide a packed lunch for your child.** It is likely to be a very hot day so please ensure students have sunscreen, plenty of water and a jacket in case it rains. Please also ensure that students have all relevant medication that might be required on the day (inhalers for asthma sufferers, for example).

Unfortunately, due to space restrictions, we cannot accommodate parents at this event. We will be taking a number of videos and photos that we will make available on the Academy website. Following the Chelsea Academy Games, students will **be dismissed from the park at 3pm** and can make their own way home. All learning coaches will be walking back to the Academy and will escort any members of their coaching groups that need to return to the Academy.
