**Changes to the end of term date**

Over the course of the summer holidays, the building is due to have very exciting development work carried out to improve the facilities available to the students. This will include a brand new Learning Resource Centre, in addition to the creation of a Sixth Form Centre, the latter of which has been specifically designed for the sole use of the Sixth Form students as a learning hub and an effective space for studying and revision. We have been working hard in the background all year to get this started and are finally at a point where we can start some of the building work.

The work will take place in two phases with the current library and G15 space being merged together to create a sixth form learning hub ready for September. The LRC will be relocated to the Lower Ground Floor for two terms whilst a new building is completed in the outside space alongside SEN. This newly created LRC space will be a fabulous addition to the building and the new Sixth Form space will provide a learning space for our significantly oversubscribed Sixth Form.

In order to prepare for these building works, the Academy will now close on **Thursday 19th July at 12.30**. Students will need to attend the Academy on this day. After coaching time, students will walk to St Luke's Church for the annual Summer Church Service, and will return to the Academy afterwards for their House Olympics assembly. These events are a fantastic part of our end-of-year celebrations and are an opportunity for students to take pride in themselves and their peers. Students will be dismissed from the Academy after these have been completed (as in previous years, this will be around 12.30).

On Friday 20th July, the Academy will be closed to students whilst the staff are helping to get the building ready for the summer work. As this is short notice, we will be able to supervise a small number of students on the Friday morning from 8.40am to 12 midday if required. Please email your son or daughter's Head of Year if you would like to have them in school on the Friday morning.

As mentioned in the CA Update last week, students who have just sat their GCSEs or A Levels will be receiving their results during the summer holidays.
