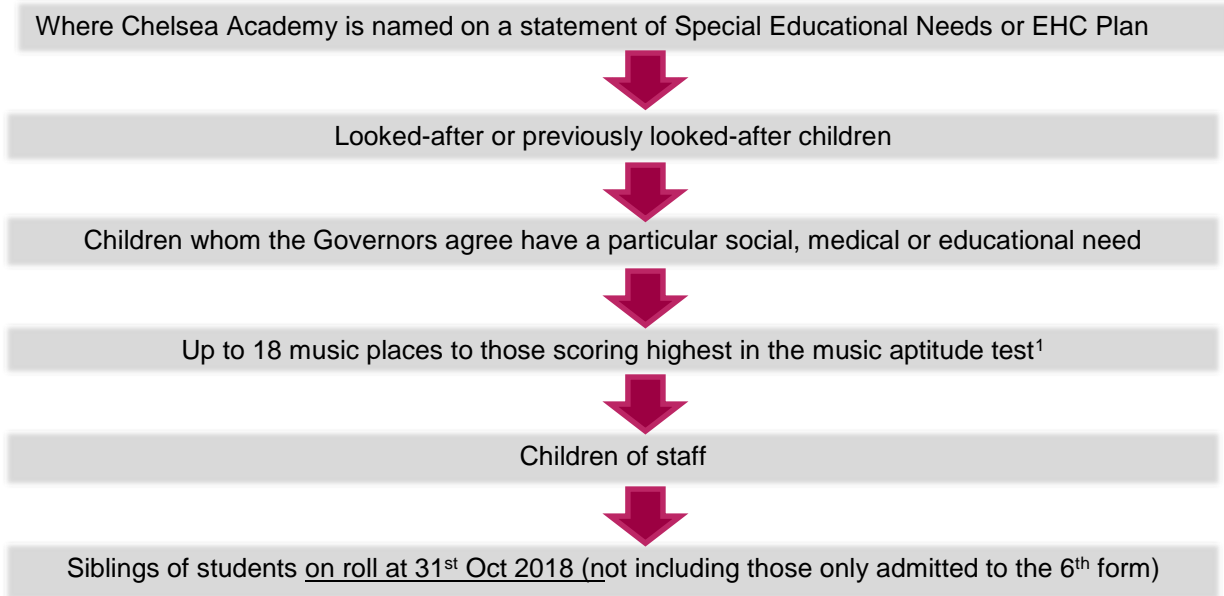


**PRIORITY FOR YEAR 7 PLACES SEPT 2019**

**We have 180 places and allocate in this order:**



**Then any remaining places are offered as follows:**

50% Foundation (Church) places	50% Community places
<p><b>F1</b> Children who regularly attend<sup>2</sup> a C of E Church in the Deaneries of Kensington, Chelsea, Hammersmith and Fulham or Westminster <u>AND</u> who attend a CE primary school in RBKC (foundation feeder school)</p>	<p><b>C1</b> Children who are attending a community feeder primary school on the closing date for applications. These are: Ashburnham Primary Park Walk Primary Bousfield Primary Marlborough Primary</p>
<p><b>F2</b> Children who regularly attend<sup>2</sup> other Christian churches or chapels<sup>3</sup> <u>AND</u> who attend a CE primary school in RBKC (foundation feeder school)</p>	<p><b>C2</b> Children who do not attend a community feeder primary school</p>
<p><b>F3</b> Children who regularly attend<sup>2</sup> a Christian church or chapel<sup>3</sup> in the Deaneries of Kensington, Chelsea, Hammersmith and Fulham or Westminster</p>	<p>If any category is oversubscribed places are allocated in order of distance from home to the Academy, measured in a straight line using the RBKC computerised measuring service</p>
<p><b>F4</b> Children who are attending a CE primary school in RBKC (foundation feeder school) on the closing date for applications If any category is oversubscribed places are allocated at random using an independently-supervised draw. <b>In March 2018 we made 53 offers to all qualifying applicants in F1, F2, F3 and some F4 applicants by random draw</b></p>	<p><b>In March 2018 category C1 was oversubscribed and we made 53 offers in this category up to 2.32 miles. We were not able to make any C2 offers.</b></p>

<sup>1</sup> Music aptitude applicants must submit the music supplementary form to the Academy and attend for a music aptitude test  
<sup>2</sup> Regular attendance at church must have been for at least one year, on at least two occasions per month. The only exception will be families who have moved into the area within the previous year and can provide a Vicar's/Minister's letter to confirm that they attended a church regularly in the place where they used to live.  
<sup>3</sup> Christian churches or chapels must be members of Churches Together in Britain and Ireland or of the Evangelical Alliance or Afro-Caribbean Evangelical Alliance
